

### The Project:

We will be building an ancestry app for Android that offers users the ability to create their family tree, write/record stories, and upload pictures! The focus will be on building a minimalistic, easily searchable platform with chapters that are easy to cross reference, find, and add to. Graphics should be simple and elegant.
